The AJ Bell Trust bought the Sandy Park property on Derby Lane in 2017 and completed a total refurbishment, converting the downstairs into Sandy Park Café and the upstairs into a two bedroom flat. The Trust has donated the whole building to Sandy Park Café rent-free.

The AJ Bell Trust is incredibly proud to have been able to support the staff and students of Sandfield Park School in establishing Sandy Park Café. As well as providing the students the opportunity to gain valuable skills and experience to help them progress in their future careers, the café is also a community hub where people can come to relax, socialise and enjoy the surroundings.
