## Sandfield Park School - Key Stage 4 Examination Results

In Key Stage 4 there was a diverse mix of pupils who were entered for a wide range of accreditations as outlined below. There were 12 pupils in Year 10 and 15 pupils in Year 11. The grade boundaries have changed in comparison to previous years which has had an effect on the English, Science and Mathematics results.

During the academic year a range of Mathematics accreditations have been trialled with some of our able pupils to ascertain the suitability of the qualifications and to ascertain the scope of the specification. We are looking at alternative qualifications to offer whilst the pupils remain in Key Stage 4 which would include more Lifeskills and practical based activities for pupils to complete as an assessment method. Those pupils who have not been able to achieve Entry Level Qualifications have successfully gained modules in the ASDAN accreditation framework.

ASDAN and OCR modules have been completed with pupils as a progression route into the Sixth Form to extend the qualification type and level offered upon entry.

One Key Stage 4 pupil was moved into the Sixth Form a year earlier due to academic ability and successfully achieved a wide range of qualifications, including progressing in BTEC Home Cooking Skills from Level 1 to Level 2 and achieving a BTEC Workskills qualification, along with Entry Level 3 Mathematics.

A total of 41 Unit Award Scheme Certificates have been issued to pupils on successful completion of work ranging from Baking Fairy Cakes, Making Cheese on Toast to Descriptive Writing.

## Sandfield Park School - Sixth Form Examination Results

In the Sixth Form the more academic pupils have successfully achieved a wide range of qualifications including Mathematics, ICT, BTEC Workskills and BTEC Safe Road Skills and Attitudes at Entry Level, 1, 2, 3 and Level 1.

Pupils also gained unit credits by completing a wide scope of units in the OCR Life and Living Skills framework progressing towards different levels of qualifications including Award, Certificate and Extended Certificate at Entry Level 1, 2 and 3.

The qualification offered by AQA in Entry Level Adult Numeracy and Literacy has been phased out this academic year and will no longer be available in this format. We have reported on the pupils who have successfully achieved the qualifications below however more pupils have been entered in Sixth Form as this qualification provided a percentage allowing us to track progress even though pupils were unable to achieve the qualification.

Those pupils who have not been able to achieve Entry Level Qualifications have successfully gained modules in the ASDAN accreditation framework.

This year we introduced the Duke of Edinburgh Award Programme to pupils which seven pupils successfully achieved the award at Bronze Level. This involved a wide range of beneficial lifeskills and practical tasks for pupils to complete. We will endeavour to repeat this success with this year's cohort as this is a widely recognised and respected qualification.
