The sixth form exam results were excellent this year with seven pupils achieving GCSE grade C in Art, 1 pupil achieving Level 2 in Preparation for Working Life (PWL), three pupils achieving Level 1 in PWL and two students achieving Level 1 in Functional Skills in ICT. One pupil achieving Level 1 Functional Skills in English (reading) particularly stands out as he could barely read up to year nine. Thirteen pupils achieved their ASDAN PSD (Personal and Social Development) 4 pupils at E1, 6 pupils at E2 and 3 pupils at E3.

Three students in the sixth form are striving to achieve their Level 1 in maths and although they did not pass this time they did improve on their previous scores. The English and Maths results overall were good with all pupils making progress by either achieving an entry level certificate or improving on their previous percentage.

Key Stage 4 Examinations

This academic year we had thirteen pupils in year 10 and eight pupils in year 11 bringing a total of twenty one pupils in Key Stage 4.

Year 10: Out of the thirteen year 10 pupils, six pupils who are working below national curriculum level are working towards achieving their ASDAN Transition Challenge to be completed by the end of year 11. (Sept 2015)

Six pupils were entered this year for Entry Level Design and Technology (food) with two pupils' achieving Entry 2 and six pupils achieving Entry 3. Six pupils were entered for Entry Level Functional Skills with three pupils achieving Entry 1 and three pupils achieving Entry level 2.

Year 10 pupils work on a two year programme to achieve their Entry level certificate in Maths, English, Science and Art at Entry 1,2 or 3 by the end of year 11 (Sept 2015)

We also had one year nine pupil achieve Entry Level 2 at maths, English and Functional Skills ICT.

Year 11: There were eight pupils in year 11 this academic year. Eight pupils were working towards achieving their Entry Level Certificates in Maths, English, Science, Design and Technology Food, Art and ICT. Five pupils were forecast to achieve Entry Level in all subjects, the remainder three pupils were forecast to achieve Entry Level certificate in Science, Art and Design and Technology.

Three pupils were working towards Entry Level 1 in English and Maths and were not entered this academic year.

Results

- Science four pupils achieved E2 and 2 pupils achieved E1
- Art five pupils achieved E3 and 2 pupils achieved E2
- D & T (Food) seven pupils achieved Entry 3
- ICT Functional Skills three pupils achieved E3 and two pupils achieved E3.

At the end of year 11 pupils would normally have followed a two year Entry Level programme for Maths and English with their work being submitted for external moderation. However, due to staffing issues year 11 were unable to follow the usual programme and they were entered for the on demand Adult Literacy and Numeracy exams as an alternative. Pupils had the opportunity to sit these exams in March and then again in June. In addition to results listed, one year 11 pupil who is in the sixth also achieved Level 1 in Preparation for Working Life and Entry 3 ASDAN PSD. (one pupil moved up to the 6th form early)
