Pupils will be able to recognise when a capital letter is missing from "I" or a proper noun. E2- Pupils will learn how to communicate information in words, phrases and simple sentences. Pupils will be able to write simple sentences to share information and answer questions. Pupils will be able to combine ideas into more than one simple sentence.</p>	<p>PreE- Pupils will learn how to recognise and count numbers to 10. Pupils will be able to match the same numerals together. Pupils will be able to say the numbers 1-5 aloud. E1- Pupils will learn how to add numbers which total up to 20. Pupils will be able to use column addition TU + U to complete sums. E2- Pupils will learn how to add 2-digit numbers. Pupils will be able to solve addition sums (TU + TU) using the column method. Pupils will demonstrate understanding of place value by 'carrying' numbers.</p>	<p>Pupils will learn how to recognise feelings related to online bullying and positive ways to respond Pupils will be able to label basic emotions related to online bullying. Pupils will be able to use a question mark at the end of a question with a prompt. Pupils will be able to choose whether a sentence needs a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark. Pupils will be able to correct missing punctuation in short, scaffolded sentences.</p>	<p>PreE- Pupils will learn how to recognise and count numbers to 5. Pupils will be able to order numbers 1–5 correctly. Pupils will be able to match numerals 1–5 to the correct number of objects.</p> <p>E1- Pupils will learn how to write and compare numbers to 20. Pupils will be able to match written numbers to numerals. Pupils will be able to identify one more/more than and one less/less than.</p> <p>E2- Pupils will learn how to read and write numbers to 200. Pupils will be able to convert written numbers to numerals (vice versa). Pupils will be able to complete simple number sequences. Pupils will be able to match punctuation marks (. ? !) to their names or functions. Pupils will be able to add full stops and capital letters to a simple sentences.</p>	<p>PreE- Pupils will learn how to recognise and count numbers to 5. Pupils will be able to match the same numerals together. Pupils will be able to say the numbers 1-5 aloud.</p> <p>E1- Pupils will learn how to read and order numbers to 20.
